Smith focuses on blend, balance and features many of these "dotted quarter, eighth" rhythms we've worked on performing accurately. The melody references an American Spiritual hymn, and also appears in Dvorak's "New World Symphony."

Standridge We show off our attention to articulation and blend and balance with Standridge's "Battle Song." This aggressive, high intensity piece closes out the 6th grade section of our program.

We open the 7th Grade portion of our program with John Lennon's "Imagine." Originally released in 1971, Richard Saucedo scores this familiar melody for concert band.
